The application period has begun for 25 college scholarships offered through North Valley Community Foundation.

Five new scholarships are being offered this year, including the NVCF Leadership Scholarship.

Last year, NVCF awarded 61 scholarships totaling nearly \$100,000, the highest total ever. There also were a record number of applicants – 162, more than double the previous high.

Applications for and details about each scholarship can be viewed at www.nvcf.org/scholarships. The deadline to apply for most scholarships is April 18.

The majority of the scholarships at NVCF are for graduating seniors who will be attending college or trade schools in the fall, but there are some for current college students.

Students from any high school in Butte, Glenn, Tehama, Colusa and Plumas counties can enter their school to see which scholarships they are eligible for.
